HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 1114, L.D. 1583, Bill, "An Act
Requiring Constructed Public Buildings be Made Accessible
to the Physically Handicapped."

Amend said Bill in subsection 7 of that part designated
"§2702." by striking out all of the last line (same in L.D. 1583)
and inserting in place thereof the following underlined sentence:
'Steps of stairs shall not have abrupt, square nosing, and should
wherever possible have risers not to exceed 7 inches.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of subsection
3,4 and 5 of that part designated "§2703." and inserting in
place thereof the following:

'3. New buildings. New buildings constructed after the
effective date of this Act shall meet all provisions of this
chapter.'
