HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1116, L.D. 1586, Bill, "An Act
Establishing Procedures for State Medical Examiners and
Creating the Office of Chief Medical Examiner for the
State of Maine."

Amend said Bill in section 2 by striking out all of the
3rd underlined sentence of that part designated "§3022" and
inserting in place thereof the following underlined sentence:
'The Chief Medical Examiner shall possess a degree of doctor
of medicine or doctor of osteopathy, be licensed to practice in
the State of Maine and be certified in the specialty of forensic
pathology by either the American Board of Pathology or the
American Osteopathic Board of Pathology.'
