STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Granting Complimentary Fishing Licenses for Certain Maine Residents in Armed Forces.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., T. 12, § 2301, sub-§ 2-A, additional. Section 2301 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended by adding a new subsection 2-A, to read as follows:
- 2-A. Complimentary licenses for Maine residents in Armed Forces. The commissioner is authorized and directed to issue complimentary fishing licenses for a period of 2 weeks or less in any one calendar year to Maine residents in the Armed Forces of the United States who are in Maine on leave or furlough. The loss of revenue to the department under this subsection shall be charged to the General Fund.
