IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Appropriating Funds to Operate the Board of Pesticides Control.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 22, § 1452, amended. The last sentence of section 1452 of Title 22 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 447 of the public laws of 1965, is amended to read as follows:

The board shall elect annually a chairman from its own membership and be authorized to employ necessary personnel, under the Personnel Law.

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 22, § 1452, amended. Section 1452 of Title 22 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 447 of the public laws of 1965, is amended by adding at the end the following:

The Commissioner of Agriculture shall furnish necessary office space and administrative and technical services for the board.

Sec. 3. Department of Agriculture; appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Agriculture the sum of \$8,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1968 and the sum of \$10,000 for the fiscal year ending June 20, 1969 to provide services encumbered upon the Board of Pesticides Control under the Revised Statutes, Title 22, chapter 258. The breakdown shall be as follows:
