COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 667, L. D. 854, Bill,
"An Act Amending Laws Pertaining to the Maine State Prison."

Amend said Bill in section 4 by striking out all of the 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th and 8th lines (3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th and 7th lines in L.D. 854) and inserting in place thereof the following:

~~'On-the~~ At the time of parole or discharge of any convict ~~whe-~~
~~has-conducted-himself-well-during-his-imprisonment,~~ the warden
may furnish him a sum not exceeding \$25 \$50~~--and--if-he-requests-~~
~~it--a-certificate-of-such-good-conduct,~~ and shall take care that
every convict ~~en-his~~ at the time of his parole or discharge is
provided with decent clothing.'
