STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Duties of Municipal Clerks.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 21, § 1255, amended. Section 1255 of Title 21 of the Revised Statutes as repealed and replaced by section 18 of chapter 225 of the public laws of 1967, is amended by inserting before the first sentence a new sentence to read as follows:

The office of the clerk shall be open during normal business hours on the Saturday immediately preceding an election to allow voters to obtain or cast absentee ballots.
