## STATE OF MAINE SENATE 104th LEGISLATURE

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "B" to S. P. 263, L. D. 867, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Licensing of Ambulance Service, Vehicles and Personnel."

Amend said Bill in that part designated "§62" by adding at the end of subsection 3, before the period (same in L.D.) the following:

', except that "ambulance personnel" shall not include persons who drive for nonemergency livery purposes'

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "<u>\$63</u>" by striking out all of the last 2 underlined sentences of subsection 1 (same in L.D.) and inserting in place thereof the following:

'One member shall be a representative of a recognized state safety association. Three members, at least one of whom shall be from a rural area, shall be representatives of an accredited ambulance service with not less than 3 years of such active experience.'

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "§63" by adding at the end of subsection 5 (same in L.D.) the following underlined sentence:

'In advising on and setting said standards the board and commissioner shall among other factors take into consideration the various economic conditions existing in the diverse areas of the State of Maine.'
