AN ACT Relating to Death Benefits Under the State Retirement Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., T. 5, § 1124, sub-§ 1, ¶ B, sub-¶ (1), div. (d), amended. Division (d) of subparagraph (1) of paragraph B of subsection 1 of section 1124 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended to read as follows :

(d) A spouse living at the time of the death of the member ~~and not remarried subsequent to the death of the member~~ shall be paid \$100 a month, commencing the first month after the attainment of 60 years of age and continuing until the date of his death ~~or remarriage~~, whichever happens first. Such spouse may qualify for this benefit in addition to any payments received as provided by division (b) but shall not receive this benefit simultaneously with that provided by division (a) or division (b).
