AN ACT Appropriating Funds to Operate the Board of Pesticides Control.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Board of Pesticides Control; appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Pesticides Control the sum of \$21,050 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1970 and the sum of \$20,600 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1971 to administer the duties incumbent upon the board under the Revised Statutes, Title 22, chapter 258. The breakdown shall be as follows:

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The Revised Statutes, Title 22, chapter 258, provides for a Board of Pesticides Control with authority to employ necessary personnel. No funds have been appropriated by the Legislature for administration of this chapter.

Funds are necessary for the Board of Pesticides Control, to properly administer this chapter. The above amounts will provide for setting up a small office with an executive secretary and one clerk-stenographer.
