AN ACT Relating to Towing of Golf Carts on Public Highways.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 29, § 102, amended. Section 102 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end the following new paragraph:

The Secretary of State, upon proper application, may issue a permit authorizing the towing of a golf cart by the use of a tow bar or a regular service wrecker. The permit may be restricted as to highways, distances and duration, in the discretion of the Secretary of State.
