STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

**RESOLVE, to Permit Mrs. Harriet McCroary of Winthrop Use of Her
Out-of-State Credits to Obtain a Retirement Allowance.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Credits for retirement allowance. Resolved: That the Maine State Retirement System is directed to permit Mrs. Harriet McCroary of Winthrop, to apply for a retirement allowance and in the computation shall include 3 years of out-of-state service, together with 36 years of service in Maine.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mrs. McCroary taught at Mary C. Wheeler School in Providence, R. I. between 1928 and 1931 and requests credit for her teaching in Rhode Island in her retirement allowance.
