of Turner for Damage by Bears.**

Robert Huntington and Floyd Richardson; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated to Robert Huntington and Floyd Richardson of Turner, from the Dog Tax Fund, the sum of \$444.95 for damage caused by bear to colony of bees.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

A 400-pound bear destroyed several hives when filled with honey, causing loss of everything; foundations, hives, honey, frames. This was reported to the Game Warden and the State Bee Inspector. The bear was later caught in a trap.
