AN ACT Relating to the Requirement for a Board of Registration.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 21, § 43, amended. The first paragraph of section 43 of Title 21 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 3 of chapter 398 of the public laws of 1965, is further amended to read as follows:

In a city or town which has a population of 5,000 or over, **the legislative body may establish** a board of registration consisting of 3 members ~~must to~~ be appointed as follows: One member nominated by the city committees of each of the 2 major parties and appointed by the municipal officers, and the 3rd member appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Council.
