IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

RESOLVE, Permitting Taking of Smelts from Townsend Brook, So Called, and Little Wilson Pond, Androscoggin County.

Taking of smelts in certain waters. Resolved: That notwithstanding the resolves of 1957, chapter 57, the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game is directed to issue a rule and regulation permitting the taking of smelts pursuant to the general law in Townsend Brook, a tributary of Lake Auburn, and Little Wilson Pond, situated in the Town of Turner, Androscoggin County, and such rule and regulation shall not be changed except by act of the Legislature.
