STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Minors on Liquor Licensed Premises After 8 P.M.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 28, § 2, sub-§ 16, amended. Subsection 16 of section 2 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by chapter 363 of the public laws of 1965, is amended by adding at the end, a new paragraph, as follows:

No minor, unless in the company of his or her parent or guardian, shall be permitted on any part of premises licensed for sale of liquor after 8 P.M.
