CONFERENCE COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1224, L. D.
1556, Bill, "AN ACT to Revise the Liquor Laws."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of section 11 and
inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 11. R. S., T. 28, §751-A, repealed and replaced.
Section 751-A of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted
by chapter 91 of the public laws of 1967, is repealed and the
following enacted in place thereof:

§ 751-A. Payment for sales in retail stores

For the purpose of receiving payment at the check-out
counters for the sale of malt liquor or table wine in retail
stores, the age of such employee receiving the payment shall not
be under 17 years of age for malt liquor if no table wine is sold
in said store or 18 years of age for malt liquor and 18 years
of age for table wine if table wine is sold, provided that in
any event an employee who is 21 years of age or older is present
in the retail store in a supervisory capacity.'
