## STATE OF MAINE SENATE 105TH LEGISLATURE

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 72, L. D. 151, Bill, "AN ACT Clarifying and Revising Certain Election Laws."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of sections 6, 11, 16 and 26.

Further amend said Bill by inserting after section 25 the following:

'Sec. 26. R. S., T. 21, §1256, sub-§5, ¶A, additional. Subsection 5 of section 1256 of Title 21 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding a new paragraph A, to read as follows:

A. Exceptions. In a presidential election the clerk shall deliver
the return envelopes with the applications received between 3 p. m.
and the close of the polls and the list required by subsection 4
to the warden of the voting precinct as soon as he reasonably
can following the closing of the polls.'

Further amend said Bill by renumbering sections of the bill to read consecutively.

## Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to eliminate the sections relating to residence of voters and to clarify the delivery of return envelopes in presidential elections.
