
SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 402, L.D. 515, RESOLUTION,  
Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution Pledging Credit of

Amend said Resolution in the 26th, 27th and 28th lines  
(21st, 22nd and 23rd lines in L.D.) by striking out the words  
"or special state-wide election on the Tuesday following the  
first Monday of November following the passage of this resolve"
