AN ACT Repealing Effective Date Limitation for County Salaries.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 3, repealed. Section 3 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes is repealed as follows:

§ 3. ~~Increases~~

~~Increases in the salaries of county officers, authorized by the Legislature, shall not become effective until January 1st of the year next succeeding the recess of the session of the Legislature passing such salary increases~~

STATEMENT OF FACT

No other department heads in government have to wait for a year for a salary increase. The increase to be included in the budget should be effective and run concurrently with the budget.
