COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 323, L. D. 937, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to Manufacturer's Warranty Concerning Ability
of Passenger Motor Vehicles to Sustain Shock."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the 2nd and 3rd paragraphs in that part designated "§ 1363-A." and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Every private passenger automobile manufactured on and after January 1, 1973, sold and licensed in the State of Maine, shall be sold subject to the manufacturer's warranty that it is equipped with an appropriate energy absorption system and that, without compromising existing standards of passenger safety, it can be driven front, directly into a standard Society of Automotive Engineers (SAE J-850) test barrier at a speed of 5 and rear at a speed of 2 1/2 miles per hour without sustaining any damage to the automobile.'

## Statement of Fact

It is the intent of this amendment to lower the speed requirements when in reverse.
