SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H. P. 708,  
L. D. 954, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Prevention by Landowners of  
Acquisition of Rights-of-way, Easements and Public Rights by  
Dedication."

Amend said Amendment in that part designated "§ 812-B." of  
section 3 by striking out all of the first underlined sentence  
and inserting in place thereof the following:

'To satisfy the recording provisions of the foregoing sections,  
812 and 812-A, with respect to land in the unorganized territory,  
the notice shall describe the land specifically or by reference  
to source of title, so as to identify it, and shall not be in  
the form of a reference to whatever land the person may own in  
the respective county or township.'
