STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Mediation Authority of State Employees Appeal Board for Employees of the Maine Turnpike Authority.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 5, § 752, amended. The first sentence of section 752 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 539 of the public laws of 1967, is amended to read as follows:

The board shall have the authority to mediate the final settlement of all grievances and disputes between individual state employees, both classified and unclassified, including employees of the Maine Turnpike Authority, and their respective state agencies, except in matters of classification and compensation.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to allow employees of the Maine Turnpike Authority to have their disputes mediated by the State Employees Appeal Board.
