**RESOLVE, to Reimburse Mrs. Edward L. Libby of Kennebunk for
Displacement Costs Because of Property Taken by State.**

Mrs. Edward L. Libby; reimbursement. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Highway Fund to Mrs. Edward L. Libby of Kennebunk the sum of \$1,200 to reimburse her for displacement and moving costs in connection with property taken in the construction of I-295 in Portland.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Mrs. Libby's property, located on Huntress Street in Portland, was acquired in connection with the construction of I-295 in Portland. Because she moved prior to August 23, 1968, she received payment only in the amount of \$200 for moving costs. Federal and state laws did not at that time provide for displacement and housing or rental allowances to property owners who moved prior to August 23, 1968. Such allowances were made to those who moved after August 23, 1968. The purpose of this bill is to place Mrs. Libby in the same category as those who moved after August 23, 1968.
