AN ACT Relating to Installation of Sprinkler Systems in New Hotels.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 25, § 2463, amended. The first paragraph of section 2463 of Title 25 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 409 of the public laws of 1969, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

All hotels or additions thereto constructed after the effective date of this Act, of any type construction, other than fire resistive as defined in the current edition of National Fire Protection Association #220, Standard Types of Building Construction, having 2 stories or more above grade level, shall be protected by a complete approved automatic sprinkler system.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to provide sprinkler systems for new hotels.
