COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 331, L.D. 978, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Costs of Investigation Where Injunction Is Issued under Unfair Trade Practices Law."

Amend said Bill in the Title by inserting before the word "Injunction" the word 'Permanent'

Further amend said Bill in the 5th line (4th line in L.D.) by striking out the underlined word "an" and inserting in place thereof the underlined words 'a permanent'

Further amend said Bill in the 6th line (5th line in L.D.) by inserting before the underlined word "injunction" the underlined word 'permanent'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to have the bill apply to permanent injunctions only.
