HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 952, L. D. 990, Bill, "AN ACT
Relating to Candidates by Primary Election or Nomination Petition
and Time for Filing Nomination Petition."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of section 3 and inserting
in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 3. R. S., T. 21, §492, sub-§10, repealed and replaced.
Subsection 10 of section 492 of Title 21 of the Revised Statutes
is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

10. Filing. Persons filing for a primary election must file
with the Secretary of State on or before April 1st of the election
year in which it is to be used.

Persons filing as an independent candidate must file in the office
of the Secretary of State prior to 9 p. m. on the date of primary
election.'

Statement of Fact

It is the intent of this amendment to make provision for filing
for independent candidates.
