AN ACT Relating to the Design of Buildings Constructed by the State or
Political Subdivisions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 5, § 1743-A, additional. Title 5 of the Revised Statutes is amended
by adding a new section 1743-A to read as follows:

§ 1743-A. Design of buildings

On projects for the design of buildings, the State of Maine and all political
subdivisions thereof shall select, without prejudice and on an equal basis, a
prime professional who may be either an engineer or an architect. The pro-
fessional so retained for a project shall perform only those services for which
he is competent and shall utilize the services of other qualified professionals
as required to provide a proper and complete professional service to the State
or subdivision thereof consistent with applicable law.
