STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Raising Fees and Expenses of Jurors.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 14, § 1203, amended. Section 1203 of Title 14 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

§ 1203. Juror's fees

Grand and traverse jurors attending the Superior Court and jurors attending on any other occasion prescribed by law shall be allowed \$12 \$20 for each day's actual attendance and 10¢ a mile for their travel out and home for the first day of attendance and 5e 10¢ a mile for their travel out and home for each day's attendance thereafter, to be paid out of the county treasury.

Sec. 2. Effective date. This Act shall become effective January 1, 1973.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this Act is to bring the fee paid to jurors up to a more reasonable amount so that it is no longer such a financial hardship for the working man or the self employed to be called to jury duty.
