## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 105TH LEGISLATURE

HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 574, L. D. 1718, Bill, "AN ACT Establishing Licensing for the Marketing of Potatoes."

Amend said Bill in that part designated "§1012." by inserting after subsection 7 the following:

'8. Maine certified seed potatoes. "Maine certified seed potatoes" shall cornist of potatoes packed under the certified seed tag or loaded in bulk and covered by a bulk loading certificate for certified seed.'

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "§1012." by renumbering subsections 8 to 12 to be subsections 9 to 13.

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "§1022."

by striking out in the 6th line of subsection 2 (same in L. D.)

the following: "or seed potato inspector,"

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "§1024." by adding at the end the following:

'3. Certain transactions. Transactions 'volving Maine certified seed potatoes shall be exempt from this Article'

## Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to:

- 1. Define Maine certified seed potatoes.
- 2. Delete seed potato inspector from the certification provisions.
- 3. Exempt Maine certified seed potatoes from the bill. Filed by Mr. Bragdon of Perham.
