HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H. P. 1324, L. D. 1736, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to Termination of Human Pregnancy by Medical
Decision."

Amend said Bill in that part designated "§ 51." of section 1 by inserting after subsection 1 the following subsection:

'1-A. Residency. Any woman requesting an abortion in the State of Maine shall have resided in Maine for a period of at least 90 days prior to such request.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide for a residency requirement of at least 90 days in Maine for a woman who requests an abortion.
