HOUSE AMENDMENT " A" to H. P. 1327, L. D. 1741, Bill,
"AN ACT Appropriating Funds for the Construction of a General
Activities Building for Female Offenders on Property at
Stevens School."

Amend said Bill in the Title by inserting after the words
"Activities Building" the words 'and Dormitory Building'

Further amend said Bill by inserting after the word "building"
in the 5th line (4th line of L. D.) the words 'and dormitory
building'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the first
sentence of the 2nd paragraph and inserting in place thereof
the following:

'The Commissioner of Mental Health and Corrections is authorized
to negotiate for, and purchase in the name of the State of Maine,
subject to the approval of the Governor and Council land located
in the City of Hallowell, Kennebec County, Maine, to permit
the construction of facilities for the housing and rehabilitation
of female offenders, such purchase price not to exceed \$80,000.'

This amendment corrects wording in present bill to allow dormitory
building along with general activities building.
