HOUSE AMENDMENT "A " to H. P. 1336, L. D. 1752, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to Boarding Kennels or Pet Shops."

Amend said Bill in the 5th line (same in L.D.) by inserting
after the underlined word "agent" the underlined punctuation
and words ', a state humane agent'

kennels or pet shops.
