## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 105TH LEGISLATURE

HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H. P. 1336, L. D. 1752, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Boarding Kennels or Pet Shops."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the first underlined sentence after the amending clause and inserting in place thereof the following underlined sentence:

'The commissioner, his authorized agent, a state humane agent or a veterinarian employed by the State may, at any reasonable time, enter any boarding kennel or pet shop, excepting any building used for human habitation heretofore recognized as not subject to search warrant and make examination and conduct any recognized test for the existence of any contagious or infectious diseases or conditions.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the 4th paragraph of section 1.
