## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 105TH LEGISLATURE

HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1345, L. D. 1764, Bill, "AN ACT to Regulate Industrialized Housing under the Maine State Housing Authority."

Amend said Bill in the 5th and 6th lines (same in L.D.) in that part designated "§ 4774." by striking out the underlined words and punctuation "laws, ordinances and regulations enacted by the State and local governments" and inserting in place thereof the underlined words 'municipal building codes'

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "§ 4774." by striking out all of the 2nd paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Industrialized housing and housing components which are not approved by the authority shall not be exempt from municipal building codes.'

## Statement of Fact

As drafted, the Bill would give the State Housing Authority complete power to override any existing state laws as well as municipal ordinances. This amendment would restrict the Housing Authority's power to override existing legislation or ordinances, and confine it to municipal building codes, the area which has posed the greatest obstacle to industrialized housing.
