**RESOLVE, Authorizing Conveyance of Ministerial and School Lands by
Trustees of Town of Mattawamkeag to the State.**

Conveyance of ministerial and school lands; authorized. Resolved: That the trustees of the ministerial and school lands belonging to and lying in the Town of Mattawamkeag, as established by the Revised Statutes, Title 13, chapter 93, subchapter V, are authorized and empowered to convey the same to the State of Maine for the use of the State Park and Recreation Commission for park and recreational uses, as a gift to the State or for the nominal consideration of \$1.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Title 13, section 3164, authorizes the trustees to sell and convey the ministerial and school lands of the town. It is questionable that without legislative authority they are empowered to convey the same as a gift or for a nominal consideration. The purpose of this Resolve is to authorize such conveyance. This conveyance was authorized by the voters of the town at town meeting in March, 1971.
