HOUSE AMENDMENT "B " to H. P. 1361, L. D. 1776, RESOLVE,  
Providing Minimum Retirement Benefits for Certain Teachers.

Amend said Resolve by striking out in the 7th and 8th lines  
from the end (same in L. D.) the words and punctuation "; and  
be it further" and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Mrs. Leslie Stillwell, Hodgdon, Maine

Mrs. Myrtle S. Elliott, 154 Maine Avenue, Farmingdale, Maine;  
and be it further'

Further amend said Resolve in the 4th and 5th lines from the  
end (4th from end in L. D.) by striking out in 2 places the  
figure "\$27,840" and inserting in place thereof the figure '\$29,760'
