SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to S. P. 610, L. D. 1788, Bill,
"AN ACT Revising the Maine Land Use Regulation Commission Law."

Amend said Bill in section 5 by striking out all of the first paragraph of subsection 3 in that part designated "§ 685-B." and inserting in place thereof the following:

'If the commission determines to hold a hearing on an application, it shall hold such hearing within 30 days of receiving the application. At least 15 days prior to the hearing, notices of the date, time and place thereof shall be sent to the applicant and to appropriate state and federal agencies. Public notice shall be given 3 publications in the state paper and such daily papers published in the State as is determined will bring the proposals to the attention of all interested parties; the date of the first publication to be at least 15, and the last publication to be at least 3, days prior to the hearing.'


Further amend said Bill in section 5 by striking out in the first line of the 3rd paragraph of subsection 3 of that part designated "§ 685-B." (same in L. D.) the underlined figure "45" and inserting in place thereof the underlined figure "30"

Statement of Fact

The purpose of the amendment is to change the time to hold a hearing from 45 days to 30 days after receiving the application.
