HOUSE AMENDMENT "B " to H.P. 1387, L.D. 1810, Bill, "AN
ACT Relating to Power to Loan under State Housing Authority's Law."

Amend said Bill by striking out the period at the end and
adding the following: except that such loans as shall be made
hereunder shall be made exclusively for housing projects which
shall be either insured, guaranteed or assisted by the Federal
Government and shall not pledge the faith and credit of the State
of Maine.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide that the loans
shall not pledge the credit of the State of Maine and shall be
insured by the Federal Government.
