SENATE AMENDMENT "D" to H. P. 1388, L. D. 1811, Bill, "AN ACT Making Supplemental Appropriations for the Expenditures of State Government and for Other Purposes for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1972 and June 30, 1973 and Raising Revenue for Funding Thereof."

Amend said Bill in Section A by inserting before the caption "TREASURER OF STATE" the following:

'UNIVERSITY OF MAINE

All Other	1,000,000	1,000,000

To provide additional appropriations necessary for salary increases equal to those for state employees for the classified employees of the University of Maine and cost of living adjustments for professional and administrative employees.

Further amend said Bill by amending the last 3 lines in section A as to the "TOTAL APPROPRIATIONS" to reflect the purpose of this amendment.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide a pay raise for University of Maine classified employees and cost of living adjustments for professional and administrative employees.
