**AN ACT Relating to Application of Prior Private Detective Laws to
Watch, Guard or Patrol Agencies.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 32, § 3804, sub-§ 11, amended. Subsection 11 of section 3804 of Title 32 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 582 of the public laws of 1971, is amended by adding at the end, the following new paragraph:

This subsection shall not apply to a watch, guard or patrol agency.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to clarify the private detective law as to application of prior laws to watch, guard or patrol agencies.
