COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 624, L. D. 822, Bill,  
"AN ACT Relating to Personal Recognizances in Violation  
of Baxter State Park Laws and Regulations."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the end, before the  
Statement of Fact, the following underlined paragraph:

'If such person initially provides said agent or  
representative with sufficient evidence of the fact that said  
person is a resident of the State of Maine, the agent or  
representative shall, in lieu of arrest, issue a summons  
to said person to appear before the nearest District Court  
on a specified date to answer the specified charges against  
him.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide that a summons  
issue, in lieu of arrest, against Maine residents who are  
charged with violating any state law, rule or regulation  
of the Baxter State Park Authority, or rule or regulation  
of the Department of Inland Fisheries and Game.
