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**AN ACT** Relating to Snow Removal on State Highways in Built-up Sections  
of Certain Municipalities.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 23, § 1001, amended. The last paragraph of section 1001 of Title 23 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding a new sentence at the end to read as follows:

Cities and towns which remove snow from those sections of a state highway, as provided by this paragraph, and when necessary apply sand, gravel or other materials within a reasonable length of time after surface of the road becomes slippery, shall be reimbursed for the cost thereof to the extent of \$500 per mile.

FISCAL NOTE

The estimated cost to the General Highway Fund would amount to approximately \$155,500 per year.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to reimburse municipalities for winter maintenance of state highways in compact areas at the rate of \$500 per mile.
