SENATE AMENDMENT " B" to H. P. 648, L. D. 864, Bill, "AN ACT to Authorize the Commissioner of Sea and Shore Fisheries to enter into an Agreement to Lease the Land, Buildings and Facilities of the National Marine Fisheries Service Biological Laboratory at Boothbay Harbor."


Amend said Bill by striking out all of section 4 and inserting in place thereof the following:

Sec. 4. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Sea and Shore Fisheries the sum of \$285,000 to carry out the purposes of this Act. The breakdown shall be as follows:

Statement of Fact

The budget item "TRIGOM" identifies a marine research program in which we have a strong research interest. TRIGOM proposes to carry out this program, in cooperation with Sea and Shore Fisheries' scientists, at the federal facilities at Boothbay Harbor referred to in the bill. If this budget is funded as proposed, the Department of Sea and Shore Fisheries would contract with TRIGOM to carry on its proposed research.
