COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to H.P. 979, L.D. 1293, Bill,
"AN ACT to Make Murder Punishable by Death."

Amend said Bill in the Title by striking out the word
"Death" and inserting in place thereof the following:
'Imprisonment for Life without Parole'

Further amend said Bill in the 6th line (5th and 6th
lines of L.D.) after the enacting clause, by striking out
the words "~~imprisonment-for-life~~ death" and inserting in
place thereof the following: 'imprisonment for life without
parole'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide that a
person who is found guilty of murder and sentenced to
imprisonment for life not be eligible for parole.
