STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT to Make Murder Punishable by Death.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 17, § 2651, amended. Section 2651 of Title 17 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

§ 2651. Definition

Whoever unlawfully kills a human being with malice aforethought, either express or implied, is guilty of murder and shall be punished by imprisonment for life death.
