STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FOUR

AN ACT Relating to Salary of the Administrative Assistant, Supreme Judicial Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 2, § 6, sub-§ 5, amended. Subsection 5 of section 6 of Title 2 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by section 2 of chapter 500 of the public laws of 1973, is amended to read as follows:

The salaries of the following state officials and employees to no more 5. than \$19,500:

Adjutant General;

Chairman of the Industrial Accident Commission;

Administrative Assistant, Supreme Judicial Court;

Director of Labor and Industry;

General Counsel of the Public Utilities Commission;

Deputy Chief of the State Police;

Director of Transportation of the Public Utilities Commission;

Employment Security Commission members, other than the Chairman:

Manager of Industrial Building Authority;

Assistant Director of Legislative Research;

Assistant Legislative Finance Officer;

State Archivist.

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 4, § 12, reenacted. Section 12 of Title 4 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 467 of the public laws of 1969 and as repealed by section 3 of chapter 531 of the public laws of 1971, is reenacted to read as follows:

§ 12. Compensation

The Administrative Assistant to the Chief Justice shall receive an annual compensation in an amount which is \$1,500 less than that of a Superior Court Justice.

Sec. 3. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Supreme Judicial and Superior Courts the sum of \$2,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1975. The breakdown shall be as follows:
