**AN ACT to Permit Lakeville Plantation to use a Public
Lot for Sanitary Landfill.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Lakeville Plantation landfill disposal area authorized. The District of the Bureau of Forestry, on behalf of the inhabitants of Lakeville Plantation in the County of Penobscot, is authorized to utilize a portion of the public lot located on the road to Bottle Lake for sanitary landfill disposal area.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The existing dump serving Lakeville Plantation has been ordered closed effective this Fall and their only recourse besides private property is to establish a sanitary landfill area on a public lot in order to do this the Director of Forestry must have authorization from the Legislature.
