IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FOUR

AN ACT Repealing Two-year Limitation in Contracts Between University of Maine and Colleges Outside of Maine to Provide Additional Educational Opportunities.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1953, c. 122, amended. The 2nd sentence of chapter 122 of the private and special laws of 1953 is repealed as follows:

Such contracts shall be approved by the governor and council; for a term not exceeding 2 years and within available appropriations

STATEMENT OF FACT

The University of Maine has been and will be turning more frequently to contracts with other institutions of higher education in order to achieve educational program objectives. The purpose of the bill is to repeal from the law the 2-year restriction on contracts and the requirement of approval by the Governor and Council for each contract.
