STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FOUR

AN ACT to Authorize the Construction of a District Court Facility in Lewiston.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Appropriation. There is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$500,000 to the District Court Fund to purchase land and construct a building, or to purchase an existing building in Lewiston, to be used for quarters for Maine District Court serving the Lewiston area.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to allow the District Court to build or buy an adequate district court facility for the Lewiston area.
