STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FOUR

AN ACT to Establish a Vocational Training and Sheltered Workshop at Camp Waban in Sanford.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Appropriation; Camp Waban in Sanford. There is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund to Camp Waban the sum of \$35,000 to build a vocational building and sheltered workshop for the mentally retarded and handicapped at Camp Waban in Sanford.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to extend the vocational training and sheltered workshop programs for those people of York County who are being released from Pineland Center. The present facilities at Camp Waban are overcrowded due to the sudden influx into the community of former Pineland residents.
